

Rehabilitation Available Services

All 3 disciplines: Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy

Collaboration amongst all 3 for many conditions:

- peds; neuro; Inpatient care – general decline and return to home or to Extended or other care environments

3 in OP/IP/ECF/SNF/HH areas

Physical Therapy

- All major service lines – Ortho, Neuro, Pediatrics, Geriatrics, Wound Care, Women's Health, Sports Medicine – focus is on Therapeutic Exercise and manual Therapy utilization to maximize long-term improved outcomes.
- Ortho: pre/post-op – all surgical considerations; bracing; return to work; return to sport; spine; etc. OCS (Ortho Certified Specialists x2)
- Neuro: CVA; Parkinson's (LSVT certifications); balance; concussion; BPPV
- Pediatrics: free screens; developmental milestone issues; etc.
- Geriatrics: all considerations – general weakness, posture, assistive device management/training, ADL training, gait training, etc.
- Wound Care: NPWT; Debridement; WCS (Wound care Certified Specialists x 3)
- Women's Health: pre/post-natal screens and care; pelvic floor issues; incontinence; painful intercourse; biofeedback/strengthening; etc.
- Sports Medicine: school clinics; game coverage; concussion management/Return to Play
- Manual Skillsets are extensive: Dry Needling certifications; HVLA/Grade V and all other mobilizations; IASTM; MFR; etc. A provider currently in a Manual Fellowship.

Occupational Therapy

- All major service lines – Ortho, Neuro, Pediatrics, Geriatrics, Splinting, Wheelchair assessments (collaborative with DME providers), Worksite/Ergonomic evaluations & recommendations.
- Ortho: distal UE specialists; Medial/Lateral epicondylitis; nerve/tendon glides; OTS and custom splinting
- Neuro: CVA; Parkinson's (LSVT certs); entrapments; Carpal Tunnel
- Pediatrics: as above; provide all school-based services for the area including early intervention; picky eaters/food aversions
- Geriatrics: Arthritic and other adaptations (eating, ADL's, etc.); cognition improvement
